- 1. Moisten the Area
- 2. Wait
- 3. Scrub
- 4. Disinfect (Optional)

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Dish soap
- Stiff brush with natural bristles
- Chlorine (optional)

1. Moisten the Area

Dampen the area with water. A good tip is to add a bit of dish soap to the water. This reduces surface tension, making the dampening more effective and the subsequent cleaning easier.

2. Wait

Let the solution sit for a few hours.

3. Scrub

Scrub the area with a stiff brush.

Note: Do not use a steel brush, as steel residues can cause rust stains on the slate!

4. Disinfect (Optional)

It's usually not necessary, but you can wash the area with a disinfectant like chlorine after the moss or algae removal.

Rinse thoroughly afterward.
