## Download PDF

- 1. Find the Appropriate Cleavage Plane
- 2. Strike with a Chisel
- 3. Trimming

YOU'LL NEED:

Slate bricks  $\rightarrow$ 

- Chisel (pointed)
- Hammer

Locate a natural cleavage plane in the brick that best matches the height needed for your wall.

## 2. Strike with a Chisel

Place the chisel directly on the stripe (cleavage plane). Strike the chisel with short and precise blows until the brick splits.



## 3. Trimming

Sometimes, parts of the next cleavage layer might remain, causing a rough edge. This is easily "trimmed" away by positioning the chisel relatively horizontally against the remaining part of the cleavage layer and striking it off.
